D.1 Official Community Plan Update Consultation

Committee received a presentation from Lauren Klose, Manager of Community Planning, regarding the Official Community Plan update Consultation

- New multi-unit housing being built in Victoria requiring a minimum number of units to be 3 bedrooms or more to accommodate families
- Difficulties experienced by vulnerable populations to find housing in the City
- Considering future residents in the risk assessment of the OCP update
- Risk of gentrification
- Emphasis on transportation for people who work but don't live downtown
- The City of Victoria's stakeholder meeting with the Chamber of Commerce
- Improving existing infrastructure
- Overview of public transit and transportation consultation completed to date
- Necessity of ongoing, high-level communication with the Provincial Government
- Stakeholder meetings with Island Health, School District 61, and BC Transit
- Environmental and agricultural heritage
- The Capital Regional District's Regional Growth Strategy
