- Community concerns regarding racial profiling of families at recreation centres and by landlords and sheltering providers
 - The City of Victoria's accessibility reporting mechanism as a tool for reporting and investigating experiences of racism within the City

 - Desire to invite community leaders to share their communities' experiences
- Purpose-Built Rental Buildings
 - City of Victoria, through the Equity, Diversity & Inclusion office, working with property managers and owners of purpose-built rental buildings to provide support to ensure an equitable tenancy selection process
 - Challenges of ensuring an equitable process if landlord is an individual versus a corporation
- Overview of ongoing and upcoming events hosted by the Victoria Immigrant and Refugee Centre Society (VIRCS)
 - o AGM to be held September 18th
 - Upcoming open house at VIRCS to spread awareness of programming
- Overview of ongoing and upcoming events hosted by the Philippine Bayanihan Community Centre
 - Support and welcoming event for students coming from Philippines to attend UVic

- Future of Bayanihan community centre and upcoming discussions with Victoria MLA and City of Victoria Mayor
- Overview of ongoing and upcoming events hosted by the Vancouver Island Brazillian Cultural Association
 - Summer series of dancing classes at George Jay Park
 - Coordination of a blood drive
- Overview of ongoing and upcoming events hosted by the Greater Victoria Public Library (GVPL)
 - Addition of two new permanent staff positions geared toward community development, safety and inclusion:
 - Community Navigator
 - Safety and Security Coordinator
 - Addressing the challenge of balancing the need for security with friendliness and while promoting inclusion
- Overview of City of Victoria projects in progress:
 - Mapping out equities & inequities project
 - Resource allows users to view neighbourhoods to understand where gaps are with access to recreation, support services, etc.
 - Considering intersectionality of different groups
 - BlindSquare application
 - Assists those with visual impairment to navigate spaces
 - Intention to offer in languages in addition to English
 - "Complete Communities" Grant funding from the Union of BC Municipalities
 - Research and analysis on the livability, accessibility and welcoming nature of communities within the City
 - Welcoming City Advisory Committee to be engaged
- Challenges faced by newcomers in navigating recreation programming and education system
 - Language barriers and lack of translating services
- Need for additional, subsidized supports for children and families to learn English
